Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

Show Pass

Federation Show Pass fee. The amount of the Show Pass fee will be established annually by the Federation. The fee must be collected by all appropriate competitions and remitted to the Federation (for exceptions see GR901.9). Non-US citizens who are members in good standing of their National Federations are exempt from payment of the Federation Show Pass fee. Eligible exhibitors are prohibited from obtaining more than one (1) Show Pass per competition year. While riders and owners are eligible for one Show Pass, trainers and coaches are no longer eligible to participate under a Show Pass and must be an Active USEF member. Anyone that signs an entry blank or acts as a trainer or coach must be an Active USEF member and is not eligible for a Show Pass. Show Pass purchases can only be made online by exhibitors.

DIRECTIONS TO THE NYS FAIRGROUNDS

New York State Fairgrounds, 581 State Fair Blvd., Syracuse, NY 13209. Gate 2 is the main entrance.

From the west: Exit 39 from Interstate 90 (the NYS Thruway). Follow Rt 690 East to the Fairgrounds.

From the east: As above or Exit 34A from Interstate 90. Follow Rt 481 South to Rt 690 West to the Fairgrounds. Exit 39 is closer to the Fairgrounds and is recommended.

From the north: Route 81 South to Rt 690 West, to Fairgrounds

From the south: Route 81 North to Rt 690 West, to Fairgrounds.

Campers & RVs – The RV Park on the grounds is available. Spaces are 45x22 and include 50-amp electrical hookups, water, and sewer. There are 136 - 50x15 spaces with electric, water, and sewer available in the Belle Isle area, near the 4-H barns. Spaces along the fence by the DVM barn and Coliseum are 30x15 with water and 30-amp electrical service but no sewage hookup. There are four dumping stations on the grounds, or a pump truck (if available) will come in for a fee. All spaces are \$265 from Monday to Sunday. Should you wish to arrive early, prior arrangements may be made with the show manager at an additional \$35.00 per day.

Entries close August 13, 2023

- **ELECTRONIC ENTRIES VIA WWW.HORSESHOWSONLINE.COM ARE PREFERRED.**
- **ACADEMY ENTRIES ARE ON A SEPARATE ENTRY FORM AND CLOSE ON AUGUST 13, 2023**
- A basic Horse Shows Online account is **free**. With a basic Horse Shows Online account you can submit online entries to participating horse shows. **If you have never used the site**, select **Online Show Entry** from the banner near the top and follow the instructions to create an account and complete your entries.
- Payment may be made by credit card by phone (607-731-9572) or by mailing a signed, blank check to Pam Turner, 584 Ridge Rd, Horseheads, NY 14845. **No stalls will be assigned without pre-payment.**
- **OFFICE HOURS: Check in BY APPOINTMENT ONLY.** All exhibitors (including dressage exhibitors) are required to both CHECK IN in the show office in the Main Barn. Appointments may be made at SignUpGenius.com home page and putting in the following email address pturner584@yahoo.com or call Pam Turner at 607-731-9572.
- **MONDAY – NOON TO 5 PM BY APPOINTMENT ONLY.**
- **TUESDAY – BY APPOINTMENT ONLY. 8 AM – 12 PM. CLOSED 12-1 FOR LUNCH. 1-6 PM.**
- **IF YOU ARE IN DRESSAGE AND NOT COMING TO THE SHOW EARLY ALLOW FOR EXTRA WAIT TIME TO CHECK IN AFTER TUESDAY.**
- **WEDNESDAY THROUGH SATURDAY – ONE HOUR BEFORE START OF SHOW UNTIL END OF LAST CLASS OF THE DAY.**
- **ADDS AND SCRATCH FORMS WILL BE AVAILABLE OUTSIDE OFFICE OR VIA HorseShowsOnline.com and must be done 2 hours before the session. (There will be a \$20.00 penalty fee added for horses shown without entering class through the office.)**
- **PLEASE TAKE TIME TO REVIEW YOUR BILL AT CHECK OUT.** Except for USEF fees, all bills are final on Oct. 7, 2023. No refunds after this date.

- **FEES - Stall reservations will ONLY be accepted with payment. (CC please note all CC's will be charged a 4% convenience fee or signed, blank check.)**

- **Additions/Scratches** Qualifying classes are non-refundable after Aug. 16, 2023. Qualifying classes may be scratched and replaced with another qualifying class, with the same horse, without penalty. Championship classes may be scratched without penalty. Any class may be cancelled at the beginning of the session due to insufficient entries at that time. Cancelled classes will not be reinstated. Additions and scratches must be placed in drop box outside the office, **no less than one hour prior to the session.** See above.
- **Membership Cards** Proof of membership in AMHA and USEF for all owners, exhibitors, and trainers must be shown at the show office, or copies must be provided with entries. Entry in NY Member classes requires proof of current membership.
- **Refunds** All fees will be refunded upon request made to the Show Secretary PRIOR to August 14, 2023. Management reserves the right to decline any entry and to return any entry fees before or during the show without being liable for compensation. **MISSING A CLASS IS NOT SUFFICIENT FOR A REFUND.**
- Positively no back numbers will be issued until the appropriate membership cards, health papers (see HEALTH REQUIREMENTS below) and stall reservation payment are on file in the show office.
- **Safe Sport Reminder:** All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org. Any USEF Competing Member who is 18-years-old and older (based on your actual birthday) is required to take the SafeSport training, including amateurs, professionals, juniors who are 18-years-old and older, and owners who have an annual, three-year, or lifetime membership.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR HORSES:**
 - At Federation licensed competitions, horses more than 7 months of age entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. USEF GR 845. Proof of current Rabies inoculation administered within 12 months of the current show dates must be presented for each horse.
 - **HORSES STABLED IN NEW YORK STATE:** Must present a Negative Coggins test certificate dated in 2022 or 2023. Please include a legible copy with entries.
 - **HORSES STABLED OUTSIDE NEW YORK STATE (INCLUDING CANADA):** Must present a Negative Coggins test certificate dated since September 2022 and a current Health Certificate from your local veterinarian, dated within 30 days. Please include legible copies of both Coggins and Health Certificate with entries.
- **ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE:** The NYS Fairgrounds are available for arrival on **Monday September 11, 2023** and must be vacated by **11 am Sunday September 17, 2023**. ANY EXHIBITORS NEEDING AN EXCEPTION TO THESE TIMES MUST MAKE PRIOR ARRANGEMENTS WITH THE SHOW MANAGER.
- **STABLING: Stall reservations will only be accepted with payment.** Entries wishing to be stabled together must indicate so on each individual stabling list and entry form. Please identify yourself by using the farm or individual's name on the entry form. Tack stalls may be shared, but exhibitors wishing to do so must send their entries in together. We will do our best to honor preferences, but such cannot be guaranteed. Anyone who removes stall doors will be billed for the expense of rehangng the doors. Overnight stabling in vans or trailers is prohibited. Stalls added after the stabling chart is completed will be assigned in the closest available proximity to the original group. Permanent and temporary stalls are 10x10. **NO stabling in 4-H barns**
- **TBA classes:** There are two opportunities for additional classes on Wed & Thurs. Request must be accompanied by sponsorship for the class. Contact Show Manager, David Owens to schedule.
- **USEF RULES FORUM:** If there are proposed rule changes, AMHA will conduct a Rules Forum in the Coliseum at the conclusion of the In Hand classes on Wednesday morning.
- **ARENAS AND FOOTING:** Coliseum: 90' x 220', Warm-up Arena ring 85' x 190'. Both rings have Travel Right footing. The 4-H arenas are 221' x 110' with a mix of stone dust and sand. The 80'x 165' Exercise Arena behind main barn with stone dust and sand will be available for lunging during the show.
- **SCHOOLING:** The coliseum will be open for schooling on Monday.
- **FIRE AND SAFETY REGULATIONS: NO SMOKING** in ANY buildings on the grounds per NYS Fairgrounds rules. Fireproof material must be used for all stall decorations. Aisles of the barns must remain clear. Tack stall decorations must not extend more than 18" into the center aisle of main barn. Drapes may not be placed across aisles. Bedding and similar are not permitted on the floor of any aisle.

- **HEADGEAR:** Riders must wear ASTM/SEI approved headgear with properly fitting harness in the following:
 - When jumping anywhere on the show grounds
 - Hunter Seat Equitation classes
 - Dressage riders when warming up for and riding in Dressage classes (exception: Western Dressage). See USEF and DR120.6.
 - Leadline riders at all times when mounted.
 - Protective headgear is acceptable in any other division or class without penalty by the judge. See USEF GR801.

- **SHARPS:** Exhibitors' attention is directed to USEF Rules pertaining to Drugs and Medications. **Exhibitors must dispose of sharps in containers provided throughout the stabling area.**

- **PARKING:** Horse trailers must be parked in the lot on the back side of the Expo Center. Cars must park in designated areas. Cars should not be parked in camping spaces. There will be no loading or unloading between the barns while the show is in session. **This will be strictly enforced.**

- **BOX SEATS:** Reserved seating in the Coliseum consists of 6 chairs. Reservations can be made on the entry blank (\$150 for a group) OR as part of a sponsorship package that includes a class sponsorship and a custom 2' x 4' vinyl banner.

- **GOLF CARTS:** Golf Cart rental is available for \$350. All Golf Carts must be pre-ordered on the entry blank form. Drivers are subject to USEF GR 1301.7. **Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.**

- **SMOKING, BICYCLING, AND ROLLERBLADING INSIDE ANY BUILDING IS EXPRESSLY PROHIBITED.**

- **GENERAL STATEMENTS**
 - Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide any class where it is deemed advisable and to reschedule any divided class. There will be two sets of ribbons in all divided classes.
 - While classes are in session in the Coliseum, only those horses showing in the next class will be allowed in the warm-up arena.

NEW YORK STATE MORGAN HORSE SOCIETY BREEDERS' FUTURITY

Entry Fee \$40

Owners of entries in all Futurity and Futurity Alumni classes **must be members** of the New York Morgan Horse Society. All foals must be products of stallions and mares nominated before July 15th of the weanling year. To be eligible, the yearling, 2 yr. old and 3 yr. old must have been nominated (not necessarily shown) in the weanling, yearling, 2 yr. old and 3 yr. old divisions, respectively. All payments are to be made to the Futurity by 5pm Tuesday, September 13th. Any payments after 5pm Tuesday, until 12/31, are considered late and will be accepted at double the normal fees. Each age group will be shown in two divisions: (A) Colts, **includes stallions and geldings**, and (B) Fillies. Champion and Reserve will be named for each age group. PLEASE PROVIDE COPIES OF MEMBERSHIP CARDS WITH ENTRY.

FUTURITY PERFORMANCE SECTION

Horses entered, shown, and judged in these classes are qualified for their respective championship classes.

57. \$100 NY Futurity 3 yr. old Driving (Thu)

To be entered the horse must be an eligible 3-year-old Futurity horse with all fees paid. Class specifications and judging same as appropriate to Park, Pleasure, Classic and Carriage sections.

73. \$100 NY Futurity Pleasure Driving 2 yr. old (Thu)

To be entered, the horse must be an eligible 2-year-old Futurity horse with all fees paid. May be shown Park or Pleasure to an appropriate vehicle. Class specifications and judging same as appropriate to Park, Pleasure, Classic and Carriage sections.

118. \$100 NY Futurity 3 yr. old Saddle (Fri)

To be entered the horse must be an eligible 3-year-old Futurity horse with all fees paid. May be shown Park, English Pleasure, Hunter, Western, or Classic Pleasure.

FUTURITY ALUMNI SECTION

NOTE: Horses entered, shown, and judged in these classes are qualified for their respective championship classes. Open to horses 4 years old and over.

39. NY Futurity Alumni Pleasure Driving (Wed) Open to all driving disciplines. Class specifications and judging are as appropriate for Park, Pleasure, Classic and Carriage Driving classes.

61. NY Futurity Alumni Hunter Pleasure (Thu) Shown and judged as an open Morgan Hunter Pleasure class.

76. NY Futurity Alumni English Pleasure Saddle (Thu) Shown and judged as an open Morgan English Pleasure class.

83. NY Futurity Alumni Western Pleasure (Thu) Shown and judged as an open Morgan Western Pleasure class.

113. NY Futurity Alumni Classic Pleasure Saddle (Fri) Shown and judged as an open Morgan Classic Pleasure class.

478. NY Futurity Alumni Dressage - This is not a separate test to be ridden but is based on the scores of the Futurity Alumni horses showing in Dressage classes. The top eight Futurity horses in the Dressage Division, Classical or Western, will be eligible for a trophy, 8 ribbons and Futurity Alumni prize money for first through fourth. The placings will be determined based on the average of any two scores at the same level. The calculated average scores will be adjusted as stated in the NYSMHS membership directory to account for the increase in difficulty at the higher levels. The horse's owner must be a current member of the NYSMHS. The class number must appear on the entry blank and class fee of \$40 must be paid.

NYSMHS STALLION SERVICE AUCTION

SWEEPSTAKES SECTION

DEADLINE FOR SWEEPSTAKES ENTRIES IS WEDNESDAY SEPTEMBER 13, 2023 AT 5PM.

Sweepstakes horses must be entered on the USEF entry blank **AND** with the Sweepstakes Entry Form Sweepstakes Entry Forms will be available at the horse show office and must include owner's social security number.

ENTRY FEE: \$60 per class.

Class 136. NYSSA Sweepstakes Weanlings (Fri)

ALL get of stallions whose service was sold and paid for at the **2022** auction, plus the 2023 offspring of the Name Your Mare lots, are eligible. See list of eligible stallions in this prize list. All entries are potentially subject to DNA testing at the conclusion of the class. An order-of-go will be established and posted in the office. A three judge, MOS system will be used to judge each class with a call judge responsible for breaking ties. For the class, entries may enter the ring from either gate and will proceed to the in-gate end of the ring to show before the judges according to the call judge's instructions. The entry will then leave the ring by either gate. After all entries have been individually judged, the judges' cards will be tabulated and the Top 10 will then be called back to the ring to show concurrently, according to the call judge's instructions. The class will be pinned in reverse order. Upon exiting the class, the Champion, Reserve Champion and one other randomly selected Top 10 entry will have hair pulled for DNA testing.

4 Year Olds – Horses eligible for these classes will be any 4-year-old offspring of the stallions whose services were auctioned at the **2018** NYSMHS Stallion Service Auction provided the service received a qualified **PAID** bid, plus the 2019 offspring of the Name Your Mare lots. See list of eligible stallions in this prize list. Classes will be judged as Championships. A three-judge, MOS system will be used to judge each class with a call judge responsible for breaking ties.

Class 139. NYSSA Sweepstakes 4 yr. old Hunter/Western Pleasure (Fri)

Hunter and Western divisions to be shown separately on the rail. The Hunter division will show first followed by the Western division. Entries shall be shown at the walk, pleasure trot *or* jog, and canter *or* lope. Extension at any gait will be at the call judge's discretion. Rail work to be judged on performance, presence, quality, and manners. Upon completion of rail work all entries shall be lined up and stripped for type and conformation inspection. Upon tabulation of the judges' cards, the class shall be pinned in reverse order ending with the Champion.

Class 143. NYSMHS SSA Sweepstakes 4 yr. old Park Saddle / English Pleasure Saddle / Classic Pleasure Saddle (Fri)

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$90), 5-years (\$360), or life (\$1,800). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$72). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan[®]/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards Program and the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program. **Business Membership (BM):** A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$240) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$35). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded, but will NOT be counted towards Adequan[®]/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$80. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$115) is eligible for Adequan[®]/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USDF
